PERFECT DELIVERY JBA SATURDAY LEAGUE PROTOCOLS 2021

- League will start at 14h00 please ensure registration by no later than 13h45.
- The league Covid-19 register must be completed prior to arriving at your venue for play and handed in to "Home Captain" for their records.
- All Scorecards to be kept by the hosting club until league is completed in case of appeals
- A fee of R10.00 per player must be paid to the hosting club on arrival.
- NO snacks of any kind to be served for the 2021 league season. This has been put in place to avoid gatherings as per the Covid-19 regulations.
Players may have refreshments after the game with their opponents, but we encourage players to not gather, but rather disperse after the games.
- WATER DISPENSERS are allowed but players to provide their own containers for drinking.
- Hosting Clubs are to have sanitizer readily available for players.
- Masks are to be always worn.
- Masks may be removed for play.
- Players wanting to play with a mask on, may do so.

Should COVID-19 regulations change, and fours or trips is not allowed the league shall be dealt with accordingly. 5 completed rounds constitutes completed league. Anything less, will result in the league for 2021 being cancelled.

DIVISIONS 1 MEN & LADIES

Scoring: (12 points per fixture: One Point per set, Two for the overall game and Two for the overall result (5 + 5 + 2 =12))

DIVISIONS 2, 3, 4 MEN

Scoring: (12 points per fixture: One Point per set, Two for the overall game and Two for the overall result (5 + 5 + 2 =12))

1. The Section Captain shall be the Home Captain on the day and shall be responsible for conducting the draws for play and recording and submitting the afternoon's results.
2. Home Captains are requested to print their section out and record the results on that specific page and forward ONLY the completed page to the office, details below.
3. ONLY: - **TOTAL SHOTS FOR, TOTAL SHOTS AGAINST and TOTAL POINTS** must be recorded. Please ensure the combined points total 12.
4. On arriving at the venue, the captains must report to the section captain to conduct the draw for the afternoon play.

THE DRAW MUST BE DONE AS FOLLOWS:

- i. Three pieces of paper marked with 1, 3, 5. These are the rinks.
- ii. The captains of the teams playing each other will write their skips names on paper.
- iii. The draw is conducted with the opposing captains drawing a skip from the names provided and a rink number.
- iv. If rink 1 is drawn, then that fixture will play on rinks 1 & 2, if rink 3 is drawn, then that fixture will play on rinks 3 & 4 and if rink 5 is drawn, then that fixture will play on rinks 5 & 6.
- v. At the end of play, each team captain must report to the section captain with their scorecards and complete the section score sheet. Each score entered, must be signed by each captain.
- vi. The completed sheet must then be sent to the JBA Office by 18:00 every Saturday. This can be done by means of:

TRIPS SECTIONS

Scoring: (50 points per fixture: One point per end (18), One point per set (3), and Two for the overall game (23) and Four for the overall result (23 + 23 + 4 = 50)

5. The Section Captain shall be the Home Captain on the day and shall be responsible for conducting the draws for play and recording and submitting the afternoon's results
6. Home Captains are requested to print their section out and record the results on that specific page and forward ONLY the completed page to the office, details below.
7. ONLY: - **TOTAL SHOTS FOR, TOTAL SHOTS AGAINST and TOTAL POINTS** must be recorded. Please ensure the combined points total 50.
8. On arriving at the venue, the captains must report to the section captain to conduct the draw for the afternoon play.

THE DRAW MUST BE DONE AS FOLLOWS:

- vii. Three pieces of paper marked with 1, 3, 5. These are the rinks.
- viii. The captains of the teams playing each other will write their skips names on paper.
- ix. The draw is conducted with the opposing captains drawing a skip from the names provided and a rink number.
- x. If rink 1 is drawn, then that fixture will play on rinks 1 & 2, if rink 3 is drawn, then that fixture will play on rinks 3 & 4 and if rink 5 is drawn, then that fixture will play on rinks 5 & 6.
