**CIRCULAR NO: JBA 88-2021**

**DRESS CODE, CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL & BOWLERS ETIQUETTE**

With one of the goals for our 5 Year Plan being to focus on the Marketing of bowls, it is essential for us to portray the correct image and thus starting with our dress code.

The JBA Executive requests that all bowlers comply and also requests club committees and technical officials on duty, to take some action where needed if the below points are not adhered to. Ultimately, clubs will be held responsible for the Dress and behavior of their members.

- **Dress Code: (As per the JBA COP Point 5, see italics)**
  - *Players may wear their club colours or whites for all matches up until the semi-finals; club colours MUST be worn for the semi-finals and final games.*
  - *All players in a side/team must be uniformly dressed*
  - All clubs are requested to register their primary and secondary (if applicable), club colours and design with the JBA office by no later than the **4<sup>th</sup> January 2022**.
  - NO three-quarter pants to be worn by men. Must either be short or long pants
  - NO Cargo pants are permitted
  - NO rugby shorts are to be worn
  - NO denim
  - NO long socks with crazy colourful designs are allowed.
  - Ladies – no ski pants
  - Hats and caps – Club registered or plain white caps or club colours with a simple manufacture brand.
  - NO District Caps are to be worn when wearing club colours
  - Footwear – for us to improve our greens please make sure all footwear complies with the regulations stipulated by the Greens Standing Committee and the official Law Books.
- **Drinking of Alcohol & Smoking**
  - Smoking is only permitted further than 2 meters from the green
  - No drinking is permitted ON and OFF the green whilst a JBA Competition is in progress. Social club competitions/tournaments will be at the discretion of the organising committee.
  - Drinking in moderation is permitted at lunch breaks during JBA Competitions.
  - This applies to Technical Officials as well on the day.
